15th Jestha

On 15th Jestha 2079, Khwopa Engineering College and Khwopa College of Engineering jointly organized a formal program in which recently enrolled students at the colleges were rendered orientation and their outstanding graduates (Gold Medalists in their respective academic program of PU and TU) were felicitated along with Rs. 25,000 cash award, with the presence of distinguished guests. At the program, MP Prem Suwal, Secretary of Nepal Workers and Peasants' Party(NWPPP), academic institutions stated the by Bhaktapur Municipality undertaken have been successful in providing quality education at affordable fee.

Mentioning that development has been swiftly achieved in Democratic People's Republic of Korea due to high number of engineers in the country, he assured Bhaktapur Municipality has run engineering colleges after discovering a need of competent engineers in Nepal, too. MP Suwal articulated the possibility of providing MBBS Course at the cost of 15 Lakh rupees if Khwopa Univesity is allowed to establish and run. He remarked Nepal Government has put the cost of MBBS course to be 40 lakh rupees, but the cost has reached 70 lakh rupees, while in practice, and it has become inaccessible to the people from the common strata.

Meeting with International Researchers

Principal of Khwopa Engineering College Er. Sujan Maka and Principal of Khwopa College of Engineering Er. Sunil Duwal hosted a meeting with a team of international researchers at the college on Jestha 12. The researcher team consisted of Dr. Paul W Burton, Emeritus Reader at University of East Anglia, UK, Dr. Giorgia Giardina, Delft University of Technology, Netherlands, Dr. Micheal Whitworth, Associate Director at AECOM Consulting Firm, and Dr. Valentina Macchiarulo , Postdoc Researcher, Delft University of Technology, Netherlands. They were welcomed to college premises by Dr. Manjip Shakya, HoD, Postgraduate Department of Earthquake Engineering. There were discussions regarding earthquake and different geo-disaster of Nepal and how further research could be conducted in these fields. The possibility of future collaborations between Khowpa and different universities were also discussed during the meeting. The team visited the college premises and observed (Master in Earth quake Engineering) MEQ students conducting experiments. Coordinator of R&D Unit, Dr. Subeg Bijukchhen and Research Assistant Er. Sasin Prajapati were also present in the meeting. The researchers are members of Earthquake Engineering Field Investigation Team (EEFIT), a joint venture of universities and industries that conducts field investigation following any major earthquakes. The researchers had visited Nepal after the 2072 Gorkha Earthquake to study the damage to monuments and structures and this visit was to follow up on the post-earthquake constructions of those monuments and structures. After the meeting, the team visited different sites in Bhaktapur as the part of the field investigation.
